- Providing a safe space to listen to anyone facing a crisis pregnancy (Listening Skills)
- Keep up to client information in accordance with Data protection legislation and GDPR
- Attending meetings and training as required

- Basic IT skills (Microsoft Office) (desirable)
- Be comfortable to volunteer within a group or by yourself
- Good communication skills
- Full driving licence (desirable)
- Good attention to detail and good organisational skills
